Supported by bold baluster-shaped trestle legs joined by a sturdy center stretcher, the design evokes the timeless simplicity and strength of French farmhouse tradition. The carved plinth bases add sculptural interest, while the distressed surface offers a soft matte sheen with visible grain, knots, and natural wear, adding to its antique charm. Measuring 86.5 inches long by 36.5 inches wide and 30 inches high, this substantial table comfortably seats eight to ten guests. Ideal for a rustic kitchen, wine cellar, or elegant country dining room. Excellent condition commensurate with age and use.
