Elegant and finely detailed, this French Louis XV style settee was crafted circa 1920 from richly patinated walnut with subtle parcel gilt accents. The shaped frame features a carved shell crest and scalloped serpentine rail over a tight cane back, seat, and armrests. Graceful cabriole legs rise to a curving apron adorned with floral carvings and a central shell motif, all highlighted with gilded touches that accentuate the flowing Rococo lines. The piece terminates in carved whorl feet, a nod to the classic Louis XV silhouette. Measuring approximately 48.75 inches wide by 20.5 inches deep and 39 inches high, with a seat height of 15.5 inches, this antique settee is ideal for a refined entryway, bedroom, or formal salon. Excellent condition commensurate with age and use.
