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Organize a bedroom or dressing area with this elegant French gentleman's valet, crafted in Paris circa 1920. The fluted brass stem rises from a tripod base with gracefully scrolled legs, each embellished with finely cast acanthus leaf motifs, adding a refined neoclassical touch. At the center, a circular vide-poche provides a convenient catchall for cufflinks, watches, or small accessories, enhancing its everyday practicality.

With its balanced proportions and warm contrast between polished brass and rich walnut, this antique valet stand is both useful and decorative, ideal for a bedroom, dressing room, or walk-in closet.

The piece is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, with a beautiful, time-softened patinated finish throughout.
