Add a touch of French country charm to a dining room, wine cellar, or bar area with this unusual antique wine bottle carrier. Crafted in France circa 1920, the decorative trolley is modeled after a traditional two-wheeled hand cart used to transport bottles and small goods. Constructed of solid oak with forged iron fittings, it features a long wooden handle, large spoked wheels with iron rims, and a suspended metal cradle designed to securely hold a single wine bottle. Beautifully proportioned and finely detailed, the piece showcases the craftsmanship of early 20th-century French artisan work. The warm oak frame is complemented by hand-forged iron straps and hardware, while the functional bottle holder transforms the utilitarian form into an engaging decorative object. Equally at home displayed on a dining table, sideboard, kitchen island, or in a wine cellar, it offers a distinctive way to present a favorite bottle while serving as a conversation piece.

The antique wine trolley is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, and adorns a rich patinated finish with wonderful warmth and character throughout.
