



EARLY 20TH CENTURY FRENCH FAUX BAMBOO WALL MIRROR WITH BEVELED GLASS

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Decorate a wall with this charming petite antique mirror. Crafted in France circa 1920, the small-scale piece features a finely turned faux bamboo wood frame, constructed with cylindrical rails, rounded corner joints, and protruding spindle finials that give the mirror its distinctive decorative presence. Its compact proportions make it ideal for layering into a gallery wall, styling above a console, or adding interest to a vignette.

The frame is finished in a warm honey-toned patina, highlighting the natural wood grain and enhancing the organic bamboo-inspired design popular in the early 20th century. The mirror retains its beveled glass plate, offering a clear reflection framed by subtle angled edges that catch the light beautifully.

The antique mirror is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, with light wear to the wood finish consistent with age. The piece is fitted with hanging hardware on the reverse for easy installation.
