Decorate a powder room or hallway with this elegant antique wall mirror, crafted in France circa 1920. The petite mirror features a distinctive faux bamboo frame, with turned wood elements designed to imitate natural bamboo canes, joined at the corners with decorative spindle finials that add both structure and visual interest. The warm reddish-brown finish highlights the wood grain and enhances the illusion of bamboo, giving the piece a refined yet casual character typical of early 20th-century French decorative arts.

The mirror retains its original glass with light aging and subtle imperfections consistent with age, adding authenticity and charm. The back shows traditional construction with a wood panel and later hanging wire for easy installation.

This antique mirror is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, and adorns a rich and warm patina. Its compact scale makes it ideal for layering into a gallery wall, placing above a console, or adding character to a small powder room where a touch of texture and history is desired.
