The mirror retains its original mercury glass plate, exhibiting the subtle sparkle, depth, and character associated with period mirrors. The walnut frame showcases a rich warm patina with beautiful honey tones and fine grain, enhancing the naturalistic bamboo effect. The original wood backing remains in place, further attesting to the authenticity of the piece. With its slender proportions and timeless design, this antique French mirror is ideal for a hallway, guest bath, dressing area, or layered gallery wall.
