Decorate a table or kitchen surface with this charming antique French majolica vessel, crafted circa 1920 and modeled in the form of bundled asparagus spears. Rich in character and playful in design, the piece features a naturalistic relief with softly glazed tones of pale green, cream, and mauve, imitating tied stalks of fresh asparagus with lively texture and depth. The top edge is shaped with pointed tips resembling the vegetable heads, while the body is formed as a gathered bundle, complete with hand-painted "ties" that add movement and visual interest. The interior is shallow and fitted with small openings from the original firing, typical of barbotine majolica production, reinforcing its decorative nature rather than a specific utilitarian function. This antique majolica piece serves beautifully as a tabletop accent or centerpiece, ideal for displaying small florals, herbs, or simply as a sculptural ceramic object in a kitchen or dining setting. Its whimsical form and Provençal spirit make it a standout addition to any country French interior. The piece is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, with minor glaze wear and small imperfections consistent with firing and age.
