This antique French champagne cooler, crafted in pewter with a soft silvered finish circa 1920, was designed for both function and presentation, perfectly sized to chill two bottles. The oval form is flanked by ring handles and adorned with a continuous repoussé frieze of grape clusters and vine leaves, a classic motif referencing the heritage of French winemaking. The front is engraved with the Moët & Chandon name and crowned emblem, along with "Fondé en 1743," linking the piece directly to one of France's most prestigious Champagne houses, long associated with luxury, celebration, and refined entertaining. The interior retains its original removable insert, allowing for proper positioning and cooling of bottles while separating meltwater below, a thoughtful and practical feature rarely preserved. The underside bears a stamped mark reading "Étain - Made in France," confirming its material and origin. The pewter body has developed a subtle, even patina that enhances its sculptural quality while maintaining a clean, luminous surface. This antique cooler is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, with light surface wear consistent with service.
