Built in solid oak, each chair features gently scalloped ladder backs carved with stylized shell motifs, a decorative hallmark of Normandy country furniture. The shaped apron is embellished with a carved foliate medallion, while the subtly splayed legs and cabriole-inspired front supports lend a graceful silhouette with a light Louis XV influence. The handwoven rush seats add warm texture and contrast beautifully with the rich, time-softened oak patina. One chair shows some wear to the rush seating, consistent with age and use, but the set remains sturdy, comfortable, and full of rustic character. A practical and charming ensemble that brings period authenticity to any dining space, kitchen, or country-style interior. The set is in good overall antique condition commensurate with age and use.
