



EARLY 20TH CENTURY FRENCH ONYX AND PATINATED BRASS STANDING HALL TREE

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Bring refined French elegance to an entryway, dressing room, or bedroom with this striking antique hall tree. Crafted circa 1920, the freestanding coat rack beautifully blends the clean, geometric lines of the Art Deco period with richly ornamented patinated brass mounts and luminous natural onyx, creating a sophisticated statement piece that is both decorative and functional.

The tall square standard is constructed of beautifully figured onyx panels displaying warm cream, honey, amber, and caramel veining, highlighted by finely cast patinated brass collars and foliate mounts. The upper section is crowned by an elaborate arrangement of openwork scrolling hooks with stylized foliate motifs radiating from a ribbed urn-form finial. Multiple curved hooks provide generous space for coats, hats, scarves, handbags, or belts while maintaining an elegant, airy silhouette.

The sculptural base stands on four graceful cabriole legs ending in paw feet and is richly adorned with finely cast female masks and scrolling acanthus ornament. The warm aged brass patina contrasts beautifully with the polished onyx, emphasizing the luxurious materials and exceptional French craftsmanship.

Both decorative and highly functional, this antique French hall tree is ideally suited for an entryway, foyer, dressing room, bedroom, powder room, boutique, or office. Its slender profile offers ample hanging capacity while occupying minimal floor space, making it an elegant solution for a variety of interiors.

The hall tree is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, and adorns a rich patinated brass finish with beautifully figured natural onyx throughout.
