This elegant antique French vanity mirror was crafted circa 1900 and embodies the refined decorative spirit of the Belle Époque period. The oval glass is framed in finely cast silverplated over nickel, richly detailed with a continuous beaded and stylized floral border that creates texture and visual depth. A sculptural ribbon and bow crest crowns the top, lending a romantic and distinctly French silhouette that elevates the piece beyond the purely functional. The mirror retains its original plate with light foxing and scattered age spotting, consistent with its authentic antique character and adding softness to the reflection. The silverplated finish displays a beautiful, timeworn patina, with subtle tonal variation that enhances the crisp casting along the edge and decorative crest while revealing gentle warmth beneath in areas of natural wear. The reverse is finished with a warm wood backing, secured with small rivets, and fitted with a folding easel support. The stand allows the mirror to sit securely on a vanity, dressing table, desk, or mantel and folds nearly flat when closed for versatility and storage. This antique French silverplated over nickel vanity mirror offers both practical function and decorative elegance, ideal for a bedroom, powder room, or refined tabletop vignette.
