Decorate a wall or a cabinet top full of flowers with this antique French harvest basket. Crafted in Normandy circa 1920, the large elongated basket was traditionally used for gathering apples, making it both a functional and regional piece of rural life.

Handwoven in sturdy wicker over a wooden frame, the panier is dressed with an elegant central arched bamboo handle, allowing for balanced carrying when filled. The sides are beautifully executed with a subtle chevron pattern, while the reinforced rim adds structure and durability. The basket has developed a rich, warm weathered patina over time, enhancing the texture and depth of the weave.

Versatile and decorative, this antique basket can be styled on a large farmhouse table, kitchen island, or cabinet top, filled with seasonal florals, linens, or fruit. Its generous scale and sculptural presence make it a striking accent in any country French or rustic interior.

The basket is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, with expected minor wear to the wicker consistent with its original purpose.
