Brilliantly crafted in France circa 1950, this striking cut crystal vase features a flared trumpet silhouette and showcases exceptional clarity and symmetry. The richly detailed body is adorned with deep wheel-cut starburst and leaf motifs, radiating with light-catching brilliance. The cutwork is crisp and refined, extending from the wide rim through the gently tapering body down to a tiered, faceted base that adds sculptural elegance. With its meticulous craftsmanship and decorative precision, the vase is stylistically consistent with the work of Cristallerie Saint-Louis, one of France's most prestigious glassmakers. Though unsigned, the quality and design strongly suggest a mid-century production by this renowned crystal house. Measuring 15.75 inches high by 9.25 inches in diameter, this vintage French crystal vase is in excellent condition and makes a luminous centerpiece, whether displayed on its own or filled with flowers. A timeless and refined decorative object that adds luxury and sparkle to any setting, and a beautiful example of antique-style craftsmanship from the mid-20th century.
