This elegant antique-style French pastry table, inspired by the traditional table de boucher, offers a refined and functional surface suited for a kitchen, bar, or entry. Crafted circa 1990, the piece combines classic French ironwork with a balanced, architectural silhouette. The hand-forged iron base stands on gracefully scrolled legs joined by a stretcher, accented with turned brass finials and decorative medallions that introduce warmth and contrast. The apron is richly detailed with a continuous frieze of floral and scroll motifs, giving the table a sculptural presence from every angle. The iron base is finished in a rich, polished patina, with soft reflective highlights that enhance the depth and craftsmanship of the forged metal. The rectangular white marble top is inset within a molded edge and finished with a perimeter groove, a traditional feature found on butcher and pastry tables designed to contain liquids. The surface shows subtle, natural veining and a smooth, honed finish. This antique-inspired French table is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, with a beautifully maintained polished iron finish and clean marble surface.
