Place this substantial English Country style dining table at the center of a breakfast room or casual entertaining space. Crafted in America circa 1980 by Guy Chaddock, the oval drop-leaf table is built in solid oak and stands on six turned legs joined by a rectangular stretcher base, providing both stability and classic proportion. A convenient drawer is fitted on each side of the table, offering discreet storage for linens, flatware, or entertaining essentials.

Measuring a full 7 feet in length, the table opens with two demi-lune leaves to create a generous oval surface that comfortably seats 10 to 12 guests, making it ideal for holidays and larger gatherings. When lowered, it reduces to a narrow profile and can be placed behind a sofa as a large console or set against a wall, offering exceptional versatility for everyday living.

The plank top showcases the natural grain movement of the oak, enhanced by a warm, rich finish that reflects Guy Chaddock's reputation for producing high-quality American furniture inspired by traditional European forms.

The gate-leg table is in excellent vintage condition commensurate with age and use and retains a handsome, well-preserved finish.
