This elegant antique chest of drawers was crafted in France, circa 1870. Built of walnut, the traditional commode with simple lines stands on front ogee bracket feet over a thick and raised base plinth; the cabinet features four long drawers across the front including one frieze drawer under the marble. The three middle standard drawers are decorated with the original key holes in the center. The surface is dressed with the original variegated shaped grey and white marble top. The Louis Philippe chest of drawers is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, and adorns a rich walnut patina throughout. Versatile, the fruitwood commode could be used in a bedroom for clothing storage, in an entry, or it could be converted into a wonderful vanity cabinet in a powder room with the addition of a sink.
