The wide and tall mirror is dressed with the original beveled mercury glass over the original wood backing. The mirror is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, and adorns a rich patinated gold leaf finish; versatile, it could also be placed over a mantel, over a buffet in an entry, or a chest of drawers in a bedroom.
