Its surface retains a richly weathered patina with layered traces of green and red paint, naturally distressed by time and exposure to the elements, resulting in a beautifully mottled finish full of historic character. In excellent condition commensurate with age and outdoor use, this antique bench is ideal for garden paths, terraces, porches, or even as a dramatic accent in a rustic or industrial-style interior.
