The piece retains a beautifully aged gilt patina across the brass, adding warmth and depth consistent with its vintage character. It is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, with a sturdy structure and crisp detailing throughout.

Maison Baguès, established in Paris in the 19th century, became renowned for its luxurious lighting and furniture, particularly its mastery of metalwork and the popularization of faux bamboo designs that remain highly collectible today.
