Each chair is built in solid beechwood and raised on traditional hand-carved os de mouton legs, joined by matching undulating stretchers that create a strong architectural base while adding sculptural movement. The turned front legs and sinuous cross supports reflect the iconic 17th century Louis XIII vocabulary, reinterpreted with refined mid-20th century craftsmanship.

The tall, gently arched backs provide excellent support and proportion, while the seats and backs are upholstered in their original striped velvet fabric in rich tones of red, olive, and beige. The vertical stripe pattern enhances the height of the silhouette and brings a tailored, tailored look to the set, while antique brass nailhead trim outlines each frame with subtle definition.

The chairs are in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, with a warm, even patina across the beechwood frames. The upholstery remains vibrant and usable, offering a ready-to-place solution for both casual and formal interiors.

Classic and versatile, this antique-style French set works beautifully around a farmhouse table, in a kitchen dining area, or paired with a more formal refectory table for contrast and texture.
