Cast in the mid-20th century using the lost-wax technique, the work depicts two galloping horses in full stride, their manes and tails sculpted in flowing detail as they surge across a textured naturalistic base. The artist's skill in anatomical accuracy and expressive realism is evident throughout the composition. Signed David Alan Jones and marked 4/8, this piece is part of a very limited edition of only eight casts, making it both a rare and collectible example of Jones's work. Known for his focus on wildlife, horses, and Western subjects, David Alan Jones is a contemporary American sculptor celebrated for his lifelike renderings and dynamic compositions. Drawing inspiration from the traditions of classical animalier sculpture, his work is especially valued in the Western and wildlife art circuits for its blend of anatomical precision and expressive energy. Substantial in scale and presence, the sculpture measures 43 inches wide by 19 inches deep and 28 inches high, and weighs approximately 105 pounds. Excellent condition commensurate with age and use. Ideal for a grand entryway, study, or collector's interior.
