This elegant set of vintage "tables gigognes" (nesting tables) was crafted in Paris by the esteemed Maison Baguès, circa 1950. Made of brass, each of the three rectangular tables features refined neoclassical lines and meticulous detailing. The tapered legs are fluted and capped with turned collars at the shoulders, connected by delicate stretcher bars for added structural integrity and balance. The tops are adorned with the original verre églomisé glass, giving the surfaces a rich, mirrored finish with deep smoky undertones. The nesting tables set is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, and adorn a rich patinated gilt finish. The sleek, simple design of the rectangular side tables along with the mirrored surfaces make these pieces the perfect addition to a living room of any style. Whether stacked or spread out for entertaining, the nesting design offers both functionality and refined Parisian style, ideal for both traditional and modern interiors. Maison Baguès has epitomized French elegance in decorative arts since its founding in Paris in 1860 by Noël Baguès. Initially specializing in bronze liturgical pieces, the firm rose to prominence for its exceptional lighting, furniture, and decorative objects. Known for its use of crystal, bronze, and Murano glass, Maison Baguès blends traditional craftsmanship with refined materials. Its intricate metalwork and neoclassical sensibility make its pieces instantly recognizable and highly collectible. While best known for lighting, the house also produced exquisite smaller-scale furnishings, prized for their beauty, versatility, and enduring sophistication in both classic and contemporary interiors.
