Crafted in Normandy, France circa 1950, the mid-century bird statue is constructed of concrete and modeled with a gracefully arched neck and elongated red beak, capturing the quiet elegance and naïve charm associated with French garden figures of the period. The crane is finished in an off-white painted surface with black plumage detailing along the wings, creating a lifelike yet sculptural presence. It stands on slender iron legs firmly anchored into an oval concrete base, offering excellent stability while maintaining a light, elevated silhouette. The surface displays authentic weathering, scattered paint loss, and a naturally developed patinated finish consistent with age and outdoor display. This antique garden sculpture is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use.
