The substantial rectangular top is carved from richly veined rouge marble, displaying dramatic swirls of white, grey, and black beneath a polished finish that radiates timeless sophistication. The marble is shaped with a classic cove edge, lending sculptural depth and refined elegance to the profile.

The tabletop rests on a hefty forged iron base with a warm verde patinated finish, detailed with ring and bar supports that provide both visual interest and structural integrity. Tapered legs are capped with acanthus-leaf gilt bronze mounts, adding a touch of neoclassical ornamentation.

Notably, the table includes sliding iron arms at each end designed to support extension leaves, offering the flexibility to accommodate larger gatherings. It comfortably seats ten guests and can extend to seat up to fourteen when leaves are added.

In excellent condition commensurate with age and use, the table boasts a strong frame, smooth marble surface, and solid construction. A masterful balance of industrial strength and classical elegance, it makes a powerful statement in a dining room, wine cellar, or executive setting. Over 200 pounds.
