The table rests on four gently cabriole legs, each adorned with subtle carved detailing and finished in a complementary painted surface with intentional wear that enhances its antique character. The open cane sides allow light to pass through, giving the piece an airy presence while maintaining visual interest from every angle. The painted top shows expected surface wear consistent with age and use, contributing to its authentic mid-century French appeal. Both decorative and functional, this antique table is ideal as a side table, pedestal, or accent stand in a living room, bedroom, or entryway.
