



MID-CENTURY FRENCH LOUIS XV STYLE WROUGHT IRON FIREPLACE SCREEN

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Sculptural ironwork and richly carved details give this vintage French fireplace screen an elegant decorative presence. Crafted in France circa 1970, the substantial firescreen features a shaped wrought iron frame filled with elaborate scrolling motifs, stylized foliage, and gilt leaf appliqués.

The asymmetrical curves and abundant scrollwork reflect the graceful ornament associated with the Louis XV style. The dark iron surface is enlivened by warm gilt accents applied to the leaves and curled terminals, creating depth and contrast across the façade.

Below, the screen is supported by a carved and silvered wood base with a shaped apron decorated with acanthus leaves, shell motifs, and flowing Rococo scrollwork. Large carved side feet provide stability while extending the decorative composition beyond the iron frame. The softly distressed silvered finish has developed an appealing aged patina that complements the black iron and gold highlights.

Both functional and highly decorative, this antique-style firescreen may be placed before a working hearth or used as an architectural accent during warmer months. It is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, with a rich patinated finish throughout.
