The table embodies the timeless craftsmanship and refined aesthetic of mid-century French design. The occasional table is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, and adorn a rich and rubbed patinated gilt finish. Since 1860, The Maison Baguès has been located in the center of Paris and specializes in the creation of luxury furniture and lighting.
