This elegant two-tier coffee table was crafted in France by Maison Jansen circa 1940 and exemplifies the refined Neoclassical aesthetic for which the firm is celebrated. Executed in solid bronze with a warm, softly aged patina, the table features slender, tapered legs topped with classical urn-form finials and joined by delicately scaled stretcher bars. The corners are embellished with decorative brass rosette medallions, adding sculptural detail and visual richness to the overall composition. The upper tier is fitted with a clear glass top that allows full appreciation of the architectural bronze framework, while the lower tier is inset with richly embossed brown leather, finished with a tooled Greek key border that adds depth and decorative contrast. Balanced in proportion and light in appearance, this antique Maison Jansen table was designed to be both functional and visually sophisticated, suitable for use as a coffee table or low cocktail table. The combination of bronze, glass, and leather reflects the atelier's mastery of luxurious materials and timeless french design. The piece is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, with light surface wear to the leather and metal consistent with its period, enhancing its authentic vintage character.
