Hand-forged in France circa 1960, this elegant vintage screen features a scrolling wrought iron frame centered by a boldly stylized fleur-de-lis motif. The symmetrical design is composed of fluid, curving volutes that radiate outward in a rhythmic pattern, giving the piece a sense of movement and balance. Brass collar accents punctuate the intersections, providing subtle contrast against the dark iron surface. The craftsmanship reflects mid-century French decorative arts' continued appreciation for traditional forms reinterpreted with modern simplicity. Freestanding on integrated iron feet, the piece functions beautifully as a fireplace screen, room divider, or ornamental architectural accent. Measuring 47 inches wide by 31.5 inches high and 7 inches deep, this decorative grille is in excellent condition with light wear consistent with age. A refined and versatile statement piece, ideal for interiors ranging from rustic French country to classic or transitional styles.
