



MID-CENTURY GERMAN CUT CRYSTAL WINE COOLER WITH SILVERPLATE LION HANDLES

This striking mid-century champagne wine cooler was made in Germany circa 1960 and features a finely cut crystal body paired with sculptural silverplate mounts. The cylindrical crystal vessel is richly decorated with repeating faceted panels and geometric star cut motifs, creating strong light refraction and visual depth typical of quality mid-century European crystal. The cooler is fitted with bold silverplate lion mask handles, each suspending a circular drop ring, lending the piece a confident Neoclassical accent within a mid-century context. A silverplate rim with a finely engraved repeating border detail frames the top edge and adds a refined metallic contrast to the clear crystal. The base is finished with a deeply cut starburst pattern, providing both decorative presence and stability. The crystal retains its original manufacturer labels, including Phönix Cristal and Glashüttenwerke Phönix G.m.b.H., Konstein/Mfr., confirming German origin and production. The crystal remains clear and bright, and the silverplate displays a soft, time-earned patina, with the piece in excellent condition commensurate with age and use. 9.75"W x 7.75"D x 8.75"H
