Anchor a large seating area with this impressive square wrought iron and glass coffee table, crafted circa 1970. The substantial form rests on a heavy welded steel base featuring ringed column legs and gracefully curved stretchers joined by sculptural central elements. The dark patinated finish enhances the hand-worked texture and highlights the architectural character of the ironwork. The thick inset glass top provides a crisp contrast while allowing full visibility of the sculptural framework beneath. The design reflects the aesthetic associated with works created in the manner of Diego Giacometti. Diego Giacometti (1902–1985) was celebrated for his distinctive bronze furniture defined by linear structure, textured surfaces, and a restrained yet sculptural presence. This table echoes that balance of strength and refinement through its forged detailing and strong geometric proportions. Solid and weighty in construction, the table is in excellent vintage condition commensurate with age and use. Its generous square scale makes it an ideal centerpiece for a sophisticated living room, pairing effortlessly with both modern and traditional interiors. Dimensions: 41"W x 41"D x 19"H
