Created in Murano, Italy circa 1960, this elegant antique table mirror reflects the refined tradition of Venetian glass artistry. The free-standing vanity mirror features a softly shaped and scalloped silhouette, richly adorned with hand-applied clear and blush pink glass flowers interspersed with delicate scrolling leaves and beaded edging. The layered glasswork creates beautiful texture and dimension, allowing the frame to catch and refract light with a subtle, luminous glow. The mirror plate is further embellished with hand-etched and painted floral motifs at the crest, adding a romantic decorative accent without overwhelming the design. The applied glass elements demonstrate careful hand assembly, with each blossom individually formed and affixed, showcasing the craftsmanship associated with Murano workshops of the mid-20th century. Gentle age spotting to the mirror plate is consistent with its vintage character and authentic antique appeal. The reverse retains its original wooden backing and easel support, allowing the piece to stand securely on a vanity, dressing table, or powder room console.
