Bring color and tranquility to a living room, hallway, or study with this mid-century pair of European landscape watercolors, each signed Walch and beautifully rendered in luminous washes of blue, green, and earth tones. One watercolor depicts the serene shoreline of Thunersee in the Swiss Alps, complete with scattered boats and snow-topped peaks reflecting in the still water. Its companion painting portrays the softer rolling hills and tree-lined banks of the Scottish Highlands, inscribed Loch Annhe, capturing the warm, hazy light of a late summer afternoon. Executed with confident, impressionistic brushwork and a sensitivity to atmospheric light, the works exemplify the style associated with the mid-century European watercolorists whose paintings were created for galleries and resort towns across Switzerland and Scotland. The signature Walch appears on various Alpine and Highland subjects from the period, suggesting a regional artist active in the 1940s–1960s, known for lyrical landscapes and refined tonal gradations. Both watercolors are presented under glass in period giltwood frames with a twisted rope motif. They remain in very good condition commensurate with age and use. Measures (each): 20.75" W x 14.75" H.
