The lamp rises from a square plinth base trimmed with gilt tooling and finished underneath with felt. It has been newly wired to US standards and is fitted with a classic socket and harp, ready for immediate use. The tailored shade adds a clean, understated contrast to the ornate base, making it equally suited for traditional interiors or eclectic, collected spaces.
