Each hand-colored illustration captures elegant Parisian ladies in elaborate gowns of the late 19th century, showcasing the refined silhouettes, layered fabrics, and intricate accessories that defined French haute couture of the era. The first print depicts two women in fitted bodices and fur-trimmed outerwear, while the second scene presents a graceful interior tableau featuring a lady arranging flowers beside a seated companion in a tailored walking dress.
