Decorate a garden, entry, or interior vignette with this elegant pair of antique French Medici urns, crafted circa 1860. Each weighing at 62 pounds, each planter features the classic campana form with a wide flared rim over a tapered body, raised on a gadrooned socle and square plinth base, reflecting the enduring influence of neoclassical design. Cast in iron, the urns display a beautifully weathered surface with rich patina and natural oxidation throughout, giving them an authentic time-worn character. The broad rim is accented with a repeating carved motif, adding subtle texture and refinement to the silhouette.

The antique pair is in excellent condition commensurate with age and outdoor use, with expected surface wear and oxidation. One urn presents a minor blemish to the rim, visible in detail, but does not detract from the overall presentation or structural integrity.
