Almost square in shape, each plaque features a central high-relief medallion set within a deep molded frame, adorned with a gilt-accented scroll border. One panel captures a hunting dog in mid-stride, its body tense and alert as it moves through dense brush. The companion panel depicts a fox slinking beneath an oak branch heavy with acorns, framed by layered foliage, a pine cone, and a small birdhouse, each element rendered with remarkable naturalism. The deep carving brings lifelike texture to fur, leaves, and background details, showcasing the high level of craftsmanship typical of the Black Forest and French “chasse” style. The corners of each panel are accented with carved spandrels featuring star and rosette motifs, further enhancing the architectural quality of the design. The panels are in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, displaying a rich walnut patina and crisp carving throughout. A striking addition to a study, hunting lodge, or traditional interior, this decorative pair blends artistry and rustic charm in equal measure.
