



## PAIR OF 19TH CENTURY FRENCH LOUIS XIII DEMI-LUNE OAK CONSOLE TABLES

This elegant pair of antique French demi-lune console tables was crafted in oak in the late 19th century, circa 1880, in the Louis XIII style. Designed to rest against a wall, each console features a refined half-moon form with a molded top above a restrained architectural apron accented by subtle geometric paneling. Each table is supported by four finely turned barley-twist legs, a defining characteristic of Louis XIII furniture, joined by a shaped lower stretcher that echoes the demi-lune silhouette and adds both visual balance and structural stability. The oak displays a warm, richly developed patina, highlighting the depth of the turning and the quality of the craftsmanship. The pair is in excellent condition consistent with age and use, contributing to their authentic character. Their narrow depth and elegant vertical proportions make them ideal for use as console tables in an entry hall, flanking a doorway, or as architectural accent pieces in a living room or corridor.
