This elegant pair of antique French armchairs was crafted in France circa 1860 and reflects the enduring influence of the Louis XIII tradition, with subtle early Louis XIV formality. Built of solid walnut, each chair features a tall, slightly arched upholstered back, a wide generous seat, and finely turned legs joined by a sturdy box stretcher. The scrolled open arms terminate in sculptural hand-shaped rests and are supported by turned baluster uprights, adding both visual strength and refined craftsmanship. The warm walnut frames retain a rich, time-earned patina, highlighting the depth and grain of the wood. Recently reupholstered in a soft blue velvet, the chairs are trimmed with classic brass nailhead detailing and accompanied by matching lumbar cushions, offering both comfort and visual refinement. These antique armchairs are in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, with solid joinery and beautifully preserved proportions. Their commanding scale and high backs make them ideal as fireside chairs, library seating, or as a distinguished pair flanking a console or mantel in a classic or eclectic interior.
