A handsome pair of antique French stools crafted in solid walnut circa 1880, reflecting the robust and sculptural character of the Louis XIII style. Each stool rests on turned legs joined by an undulating H-form stretcher, a hallmark of the period that adds both structural integrity and visual movement. The wood presents a warm and rich walnut patina, beautifully highlighting the natural grain and age. The seats are upholstered in a tapestry fabric featuring a dense foliate and tree motif in deep blues, ochres, and muted greens, lending a classic, decorative presence. Finished with brass nailhead trim, the upholstery complements the strong architectural lines of the bases while adding texture and color. The proportions are generous and comfortable, making them ideal as footstools, low seating, or as accents in front of a pair of chairs or a sofa.
