The finish displays an aged, patinated gilt surface with some wear to the top, enhancing their antique character. These Louis XV style guéridons are ideal for displaying busts, vases, or sculptures, and bring a touch of classical refinement to any traditional or eclectic interior. Sturdy yet visually delicate, the tall pedestals demonstrate the fine craftsmanship of the late 19th century and remain in excellent condition commensurate with age and use.
