Crafted in France circa 1870, each tall candelabra features a finely fluted white marble column rising from a circular stepped base composed of white marble and gilt bronze, adorned with beaded and floral garland motifs. The elegant ormolu mounts display exceptional craftsmanship, including acanthus leaf detailing, rosettes, and a central flambeau finial at the pediment. Each light offers four curved arms with intricately decorated drip pans and candle cups, radiating from a central stem enriched with scrolling foliage. The restrained neoclassical lines of the marble are beautifully contrasted by the lavish gilded bronze elements, creating a harmonious balance of refinement and grandeur. Perfect for a formal dining table, mantel, or console, these luxurious candelabras are in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, and exemplify the timeless sophistication of the Louis XVI aesthetic. Their dramatic presence and impeccable detailing make them ideal statement pieces in both traditional and eclectic interiors. The top flame finial could be removed should you want to add another candle. One "Candelabre" a little bit crooked (see pictures). Candles not included.
