Each candle cup is finished with a flared, gadrooned rim and matching bobèche, completing the classical silhouette with balance and symmetry.

The contrast between the luminous gilt bronze and the vibrant porcelain medallions adds depth and sophistication, making these candelabras both functional lighting elements and striking decorative statements. Ideal for a formal dining setting, console, or mantel display, they also offer the option to be professionally converted into table lamps if desired. The pieces are in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, with a rich, time-softened gilt patina and crisp detailing throughout.
