Elevate a mantel or console with this elegant pair of French bronze candelabra crafted in France around 1880. Designed in the refined Louis XVI style, each five-light candelabrum features a fluted central stem rising from a shaped plinth base adorned with neoclassical motifs. The scrolling candle arms are delicately cast with acanthus leaves and classical curves, supporting cup-form candleholders decorated with vertical leaf-patterned molding typical of late 18th-century design. The bases display finely chased floral garlands, beaded trim, and foliate appliqués, all resting on small turned feet that give the pair a sense of architectural balance. The bronze surfaces retain a warm, rich patinated finish, showing the beautiful depth and character expected of genuine 19th-century French work. These decorative candelabra would be stunning flanking a mirror, anchoring a dining room buffet, or enhancing any traditional interior with timeless neoclassical symmetry.
