Crafted in Paris, France circa 1880, this elegant pair of Louis XVI style nightstands embodies the refined symmetry and classical detailing of late 19th-century neoclassical furniture. Each table is built from walnut and features clean rectangular lines over tapered, fluted legs capped with brass sabots. The facade presents two functional drawers with understated brass knobs, offering practical storage while maintaining a graceful profile. The tops are fitted with beautifully variegated grey Saint Anne marble slabs, displaying fine white and amber veining. A pierced brass gallery surrounds each top, enhancing the architectural silhouette while providing a touch of decorative utility. The side panels and apron are accented with fluted carvings, reinforcing the classical aesthetic, while the overall form retains a restrained elegance typical of the Louis XVI revival. Each piece is stamped "B.L." on the side, likely referring to the original workshop or maker.
