



PAIR OF MID-CENTURY ITALIAN CAPODIMONTE STYLE PORCELAIN FIGURAL SCULPTURES

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Striking pair of Italian porcelain figural sculptures crafted circa 1950 in the Capodimonte tradition, depicting a young peasant couple in richly detailed, hand-painted attire. Modeled in high relief and finished in a glossy polychrome glaze, each figure captures a moment of gentle movement and narrative, bringing warmth and character to the composition. The young woman is dressed in layered provincial garments with a pink apron, green skirt, and shawl draped over her shoulders, carrying a basket of fruit and a traveling bundle. Her companion stands beside her in rustic dress with a vest, hat, and satchel, holding an umbrella and walking staff, suggesting a shared journey through the countryside. Both figures are set on naturalistic bases with cobblestone and tree trunk elements, raised on ornate circular plinths decorated with gilt and green accents.

The sculptures are signed D. Poloniato at the base and marked "Made in Italy," reinforcing their mid-century Italian origin and quality craftsmanship. The attention to facial expression, textile detail, and layered glazing reflects the influence of Capodimonte porcelain production.

These antique decorative figures would make an elegant statement on a mantel, console, or sideboard, adding color, scale, and a touch of European charm to any interior.
