Crafted in France circa 1920, the matching vases are made of molded composition material and feature an elegant faceted form with flared octagonal rims raised on stepped pedestal bases. Their warm cream-colored finish is hand-painted throughout with delicate bouquets of pink roses and blue forget-me-nots, creating a cheerful floral pattern accented by naturally aged speckling and a beautifully weathered patina.

The simple architectural silhouette is complemented by the whimsical hand-painted decoration, making these antique vases a wonderful addition to French Country, Provençal, cottage, or farmhouse interiors. Their versatile size makes them ideal for displaying dried botanicals, faux flowers, or seasonal arrangements, while they are equally attractive displayed on their own as decorative accents.

The antique composition vases are in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, with expected paint wear, scattered surface losses, age-related crazing, and minor imperfections that enhance their authentic character and nearly century-old appeal.
