Early 20th Century French Louis XIII revival side tables, crafted in France circa 1920 and inspired by the robust architectural forms of 17th-century furniture. Each antique table features a bow-front, demi-lune top above a straight apron, creating an elegant silhouette well suited for placement on either side of a sofa, console, or bed. The tops display attractive grain patterns and softly worn edges, adding warmth and character. Each table stands on finely turned oak legs, five in total, joined by a shaped lower stretcher that provides both visual balance and excellent stability. The turned supports and stretcher reflect traditional Louis XIII design elements, interpreted here in a refined early 20th-century revival form. The proportions are compact yet substantial, making the pair both practical and decorative. These antique French side tables are in excellent condition commensurate with age and use and retain a warm, rich walnut-toned patina throughout. Versatile in function, they may be used as end tables, lamp stands, or plant stands, and bring timeless French character to a living room, bedroom, or sitting area.
