Woven in Flanders circa 1980 in the Gobelins manner, each textile features a richly detailed landscape rendered in a soft, harmonious palette. One panel illustrates a lakeside terrace framed by floral garlands, classical balustrades, and distant mountains, while the other depicts a romantic countryside scene with gardens, rushing water, rustic buildings, and lush vegetation. Both compositions show fine weaving definition, tonal depth, and the elegant borders characteristic of Gobelins-style verdure work. The reverse of each tapestry retains its original cotton backing and woven label "Point Genre GOBELINS – Tapisserie conçue, réalisée et tissée en Flandres," identifying the subject as "2609 Verdure Paysage."
